



## Grant Funding

To carry out its mission "*To enhance the supply of skilled workers by supporting and developing training and education programs and by improving the public image and awareness of careers in metalforming,*" the PMA Educational Foundation awards grants to provide grant funding to PMA its related entities and collaborative organizations for projects, programs and products that meet the needs of metalforming companies. Grant requests are made either directly from PMA or endorsed by its leadership.

In addition, each year a portion of the Foundation's grant budget is made available to PMA Districts for funding local training and education initiatives. Eligible initiatives are described in the [guidelines and criteria](#), and Districts can make a funding request by completing and submitting [this application form](#). All recipient districts are required to submit a report. These reports are circulated to other districts so they may replicate any that they feel would be helpful in their locale.
